



# Main objectives of ECAC's environmental activity

# Promote internationally European practices and policies

- To coordinate European positions in close cooperation with EC, and
- To maintain the unity in international debate

## Foster European harmonisation and monitor achievements

- By fostering debate, sharing of best practices amongst States and stakeholders
- By developing ECAC guidelines (common section of State action plans)
- By capacity building activities (incl. for CORSIA implementation)



# COORDINATION OF EUROPEAN POSITIONS RELATING TO PRESERVATION OF CORSIA

### **Significant EAEG contribution to:**

- coordination for ICAO A40
- finalisation of CORSIA package (SARPs), and CORSIA review: Coordinated elements of replies to ICAO State letters on TAB, emissions unit criteria, CORSIA eligible fuels, sustainability criteria for CORSIA eligible fuels, CORSIA implementation and review
- CORSIA baseline adjustment (COVID/1): assessment of options for adjustment of baseline provided to ECAC DGs and European members of ICAO Council



# COORDINATION/ PROMOTION OF EUROPEAN POSITIONS TOWARDS AN LTAG, AND ON AVIATION FUELS AND SST

# Significant contribution of EAEG and Environmental Forum to:

- coordination for ICAO A40
- fostering discussion and improving knowledge on LTAG, and sustainable aviation fuels (since December 2019)
- keeping under close review CAEP work on Aviation Fuels (SAF and LCAF) and SST



# FURTHER HARMONISATION IN EUROPE

### **Maintenance of 4th Edition of ECAC.CEAC Doc29**

- Standard method for harmonising computation of noise contours around civil airports, and validating models
- Incorporation of updates into EU legislation
- Development work to also define a method for computation of helicopter noise

# ECAC/EU guidance for action plans for CO<sub>2</sub> emissions reductions (Updated Ed° 2 June 2021)

- A section common to all European State action plans gives visibility to European mitigating actions, and supports submission of European action plans
- European action plans posted on ECAC website
