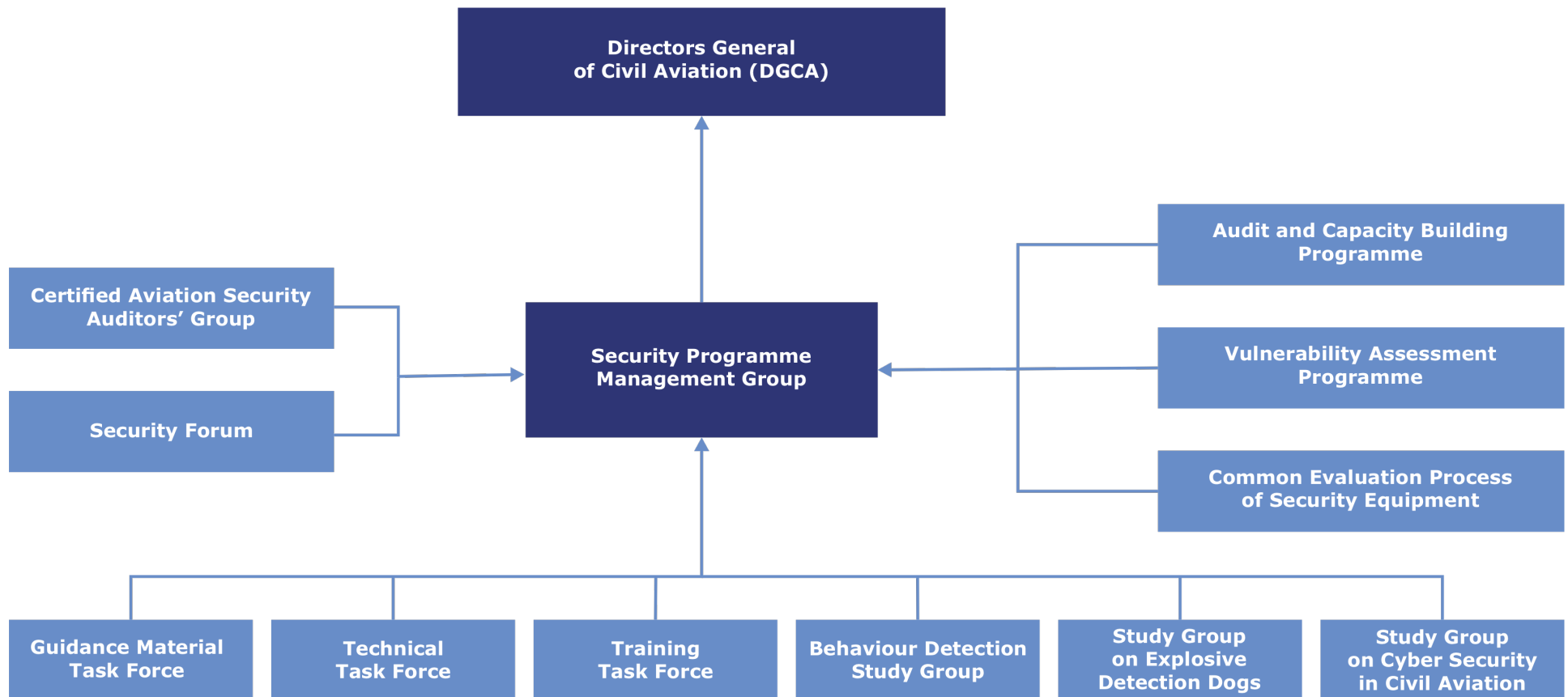

2019-2021 Priorities

- To promote a risk-based approach to aviation security
- To promote development and use of security technology
- To pursue development of efficient, effective and uniform aviation security measures on a pan-European basis
- To support ECAC Member States in achieving full compliance with European requirements
- To support ECAC Member States in further developing and/or improving their security regime
- To promote European priorities in aviation security with international partners, regional and international organisations

2019-2021 Achievements (1/4)

Risk-based approach to aviation security

- Promoting understanding of existing and emerging threats
- New guidance on risk assessment, identification of high-risk cargo, insider risk mitigation, and landside security
- Vulnerability assessments (landside, cyber security, insider threats/security culture)
- Updating existing guidance material

Development and use of Security technology and equipment

- 178 CEP tests conducted
- More than 75 new equipment configurations found to meet an ECAC/EU standard
- Guidance material for approval/use of EDDs in cargo
- Guidance material on cyber security
- Creation of Threat Group with DG MOVE

2019-2021 Achievements (2/4)

Development of efficient, effective and uniform aviation security measures on a pan-European basis

- Consistency between ECAC Doc 30, Part II and EU/EC Regulations and ICAO Annex 17 by adopting four amendments to ECAC Doc 30, Part II
- New Annexes developed and 13 existing Annexes to ECAC Doc 30, Part II updated
- 29 new documents developed for ECAC Aviation Security Handbook and several existing papers updated

Supporting ECAC MS in achieving full compliance with European requirements on aviation security

- Aviation Security Audit Programme
- Five security audits carried out in 2019
- Establishing ECAC Certified Aviation Security Auditors Group

2019-2021 Achievements (3/4)

Supporting ECAC MS
in further developing
and/or improving
their security regime

- Implementing ECAC Capacity-Building Programme and adapting to existing circumstances
- 2019: Two workshops on cargo security and explosive detection dogs organised in 2019, pre-opening survey of an airport conducted in 2019, seven training courses
- 2020-2021:
 - Nine online training courses and ten webinars conducted in 2020-2021
 - Five new training courses and webinars focusing on security equipment, auditing cyber security measures, insider risks and security culture developed
 - Two existing courses were updated and adapted for delivering online in 2021

2019-2021 Achievements (4/4)

Promoting European priorities in aviation security with international partners and organisations

- Partnership with other organisations (e.g. ACAO, AFCAC, WAEMU) and States (e.g. Australia, Canada, Singapore, United States)
- Implementation of the EU-funded projects
 - EaP/CA
 - CASE I
 - CASE II
- Creation of European Coordination Group on aviation cyber security matters
