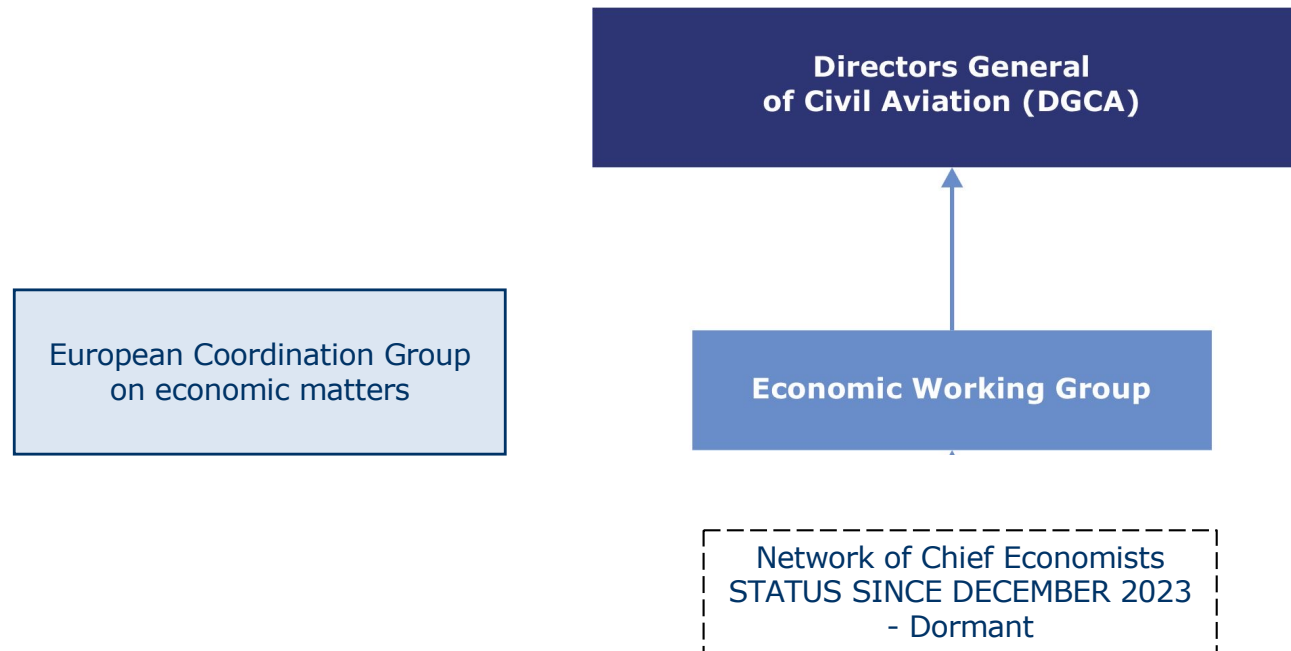
To develop economic expertise in ECAC Member States
